

## **POLICY PLAN 2024**

### **The Foundation's objective**

The Foundation aims to promote, stimulate and support art in general and contemporary art in particular. In addition to this, anything directly or indirectly connected with, or likely to be conducive to, art— all in the broadest sense of the word.

### **Activities**

In order to achieve the aforementioned objective, the Foundation will support a young artist in 2024 to help them break through with their work. The chosen artist will embark on a journey to a destination of their choice, on the basis of which they will create new works. The journey and resulting works will subsequently be catalogued in a book, and a reception will held in the autumn in promotion of the artist. An annual budget of approximately €50,000 is allocated to this.

### **Ways in which the Foundation aims to recruit funds**

The Foundation does not raise funds. Her wealth is made up of donations, inheritances, bequests and gifts.

### **Ways in which the Foundation will manage and spend the assets**

The proceeds from the assets are used to finance the trip, the catalog and the reception promoting the artist.

### **Remuneration policy**

Directors receive no remuneration for their work. They may, however, be entitled to reimbursement of the costs (reasonably) incurred in the performance of their duties and may also receive a non-excessive fee in respect of their work for the foundation. These allowances are made visible in the statement of income and expenses. The board may also decide to grant a director a non-excessive expense allowance. These fees are made visible in the annual accounts of the Foundation.
